

1 [Settlement of Lawsuit [Partial Settlement]]

3 **Ordinance authorizing partial settlement of the lawsuit filed by Ki-Man Song, Young**
4 **Soo Lee, Leobardo Trejo, Suk In Yi, Chae Hun Yi, and James Nam against the City and**
5 **County of San Francisco for \$280,540; the lawsuit was filed on June 3, 2003 in United**
6 **States District Court, Northern District of California, Case No. C03 2580; entitled Ki-Man**
7 **Song, et al. v. Jin Construction & Electric Co., et al.; other material terms of said**
8 **settlement are material terms.**

10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to settle the action entitled "Ki-Man
12 Song, et al. v. Jin Construction & Electric Co., et al., in the United States District Court,
13 Northern District of California, Case No. C03 2580 by the payment of \$280,540 from monies
14 withheld from three City public work contract balances pursuant to the assessment of
15 prevailing wage violations by the City's Office of Labor Standards Enforcement against Jin
16 Construction & Electric Co.

18 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in the United States District Court on
19 June 3, 2003, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Plaintiffs are Ki-Man Song,
20 Young Soo Lee, Leobardo Trejo, Suk In Yi, Chae Hun Yi, and James Nam; Defendants are
21 Jin Construction & Electric Co., Jin Eung Lee, Ok Ja Lee, Washington International Insurance
22 Company, Colonial American Casualty and Surety Company, CGU Insurance Company,
23 Safeco Insurance Company of America, C.M. Chiang Construction Company, Inc., Competent
24 Builders Corporation, Fedcon General Contractors, Inc., Kin Wo Construction, Inc.,
