23 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

24 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby adopts and implements the Memorandum
25 of Understanding ("MOU") between the City and County of San Francisco and the Crafts
26 Coalition: the Bricklayers and Allied Crafts, Local 3; Hod Carriers, Local 166; The Northern

5 Local 16; International Association of Bridge, Structural, Ornamental, Reinforcing Iron

10 June 30, 2022.

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14 Section 2. The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Department of Human
15 Resources to make non-substantive ministerial or administrative corrections to the MOU.
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17 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.
18 Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance
19 unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of
20 Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
