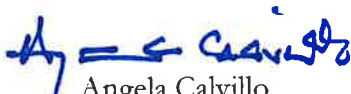

In 2016, the Treasure Island Development Authority ("TIDA") provided the San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District ("BART") with written notice of the City and County of San Francisco's ("City") plan to establish the Infrastructure and Revitalization Financing District ("IRFD") for the Treasure Island project. Notice was also provided to comply with applicable law and to inform you that the IRFD would not receive any property tax revenue from BART.

In 2017, the City established the IRFD for the Treasure Island project. The IRFD receives an allocation of incremental property tax revenue from the City, but not from any other public agencies.

In 2022, the City added additional territory to the IRFD and amended the Infrastructure Financing Plan ("IFP") for the IRFD.

In 2021, TIDA again provided BART with written notice of the City's plans to amend the IFP. Notice, again, was provided to comply with applicable law and to inform you that the IRFD would not receive any property tax revenue from BART.

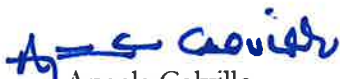
