| 9 | WHEREAS, Throughout his eight years of service Supervisor McGoldrick has |
| 10 | legislated with his heart and soul and has showed passion, courage and care in his efforts to |
| 11 | better this City that we all cherish; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, During his tenure, Supervisor McGoldrick has served as chair of the |
| 13 | Housing, Transportation and Land Use Committee, the Transportation and Commerce |
| 14 | Committee, the Land Use Committee, the City Operations and Neighborhood Services |
| 15 | Committee, the San Francisco County Transportation Authority and, finally, the 2008-2009 |
| 16 | Budget and Finance Committee in a year of unusually severe budget constraints while still |
| 17 | maintaining principles of sound economic justice; and |

| 19 | bodies such as the Bay Area Air Quality Management District, the Golden Gate Bridge |

| 22 | WHEREAS, Supervisor McGoldrick has passed many significant laws that include the |
| 23 | expansion of the popular car-free program in Golden Gate Park; protecting special and unique |
| 24 | features that San Francisco boasts, such as single and dual screen movie theatres; multiple |
| 25 | ordinances that garnered tens of millions of dollars for the Municipal Transportation Agency to |

| 6 | WHEREAS, Supervisor McGoldrick was a champion of good government issues such |
| 7 | as Bus Rapid Transit, the Mobility Access and Pricing program, maintaining municipal control |
| 8 | over the City's public assets, as well as being instrumental in the creation and implementation |
| 9 | of comprehensive community-based planning; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, Supervisor McGoldrick also created effective task forces and advisory |
| 11 | bodies such as the Pedestrian Safety Advisory Committee and the Biodiesel Task Force that |
| 12 | provide expert advice to the Board of Supervisors to make informed, difficult decisions; now, |
