3	Resolution authorizing the temporary closure of the public sidewalk on both sides of
4	Howard Street between 3rd Street and 4th Street, from October 11th through October
5	17, 2025, subject to ISCOTT issuing a permit for the event.

7	WHEREAS, Transportation Code, Article 6 provides for the temporary use and
8	occupancy of a public street for events receiving a permit from the Interdepartmental Staff
9	Committee on Traffic and Transportation (ISCOTT); and
10	WHEREAS, Transportation Code, Section 6.7 provides that the temporary use or
11	occupancy of a public street shall not unnecessarily obstruct or bar public access onto said
12	street, and that sidewalks shall remain open at all times for pedestrian use unless closure of
13	the sidewalk is provided for by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors explaining the reason
14	for such closure; and
15	WHEREAS, Dreamforce is an annual event sponsored by Salesforce, taking place in
16	the City since 2003; and
17	WHEREAS, Dreamforce brings tens of thousands of visitors to the City each year and
18	takes place at the Moscone Center and surrounding streets over four days; and
19	WHEREAS, Dreamforce has signed agreements to hold the annual event at the
20	Moscone Center for 2025; and
21	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors determines that the closure of the sidewalks or
22	both sides of Howard Street between 3rd Street and 4th Street, from October 11th through
23	October 17, 2025, is necessary to facilitate the event each year; and
24	WHEREAS, Authorization for the temporary closure of the above sidewalks is subject
25	to ISCOTT issuing a permit for each year's event; and

WHEREAS, This Resolution is not a stand-alone authorization to close the subject sidewalks; any such closures are subject to ISCOTT approving an event permit for each year's Dreamforce event that authorizes closure of the subject sidewalks and is subject to the City's discretionary adoption of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Findings for the project, following review and consideration of completed project related environmental analysis, where required; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the temporary closure of the sidewalks on both sides of Howard Street between 3rd Street and 4th Street, from October 11th through October 17, 2025, subject to ISCOTT issuing a permit for the event.
