WHEREAS, Historically, San Francisco has been a beacon for immigrants; and WHEREAS, San Francisco is a Sanctuary City and is committed to supporting and investing in the well-being of immigrant families; and

WHEREAS, Currently, thirty-six percent of San Francisco's population is foreign born, forty-five percent of San Francisco's households speak a language other than English at home, one in fourteen children in San Francisco is an immigrant, and fifty-four percent of San Francisco's children have at least one immigrant parent; and

WHEREAS, Immigrants and immigrant families have played a critical role in shaping the City's unique neighborhoods, history, economy, culture and politics; and

WHEREAS, Immigrant labor has contributed to San Francisco's economic success through the building of historic structures such as the Golden Gate Bridge, the Pacific Railroad, and the expansion of San Francisco's Port; and

WHEREAS, Immigrants comprise more than one-third of the San Francisco Bay Area work force and represent twenty-eight percent of the San Francisco Bay Area's total household income, contributing to the region's economic vitality; and

WHEREAS, Immigrants actively participate in the shaping of San Francisco's culture and history by engaging in civic life through community engagement and political advocacy, contributing to a more robust democracy in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, For the past seven years in the month of April, the San Francisco
Immigrant Legal & Education Network (SFILEN) has gathered hundreds of immigrants at City

Hall to raise awareness and visibility of San Francisco's immense and diverse immigrant communities in presentations to the Mayor, Supervisors and city staff from various departments; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors declares April as "Immigrant Family Month" to affirm the City's commitment to investing in, protecting, and integrating low-income immigrant families, enabling them to live, work, and contribute to the vitality of San Francisco.
