

1 [Accept-Expend DOC Beverage Container Recycling Payment]

2  
3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Environment to accept and expend a grant in**  
4 **the amount of \$450,330 from the Department of Conservation (DOC) for Fiscal Years**  
5 **2001/2002 and 2002/2003 and continue to accept similar annually recurring payments.**

7 WHEREAS, Recycling conserves resources and is necessary to achieve the state  
8 mandated goal of 50% waste diversion by the end of year 2000; and,

9 WHEREAS, The Commission on the Environment passed a resolution supporting  
10 adoption of a 75% diversion goal by 2010 and Zero Waste by 2020; and,

11 WHEREAS, The Department of the Environment established the Solid Waste  
12 Management Program, which manages the Curbside Program and other beverage container  
13 recycling programs; and,

14 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 14581 (a) (4) (A) of the California Public Resources  
15 Code, the DOC is required to make annual payments to eligible Cities and Counties that  
16 submit the necessary forms ; and,

17 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provisions for indirect costs of \$30,000; now,  
18 therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Department of the Environment is authorized to accept and  
20 expend a \$450,330 beverage container recycling payment and accept similar annually  
21 recurring payments from the DOC; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of the Environment Director is hereby  
23 authorized and empowered to execute all necessary forms for the purpose of securing  
24 payments and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in Section 14581 (a) (4) (A)  
25 of the California Public Resources Code.
