

1 [Expand behavioral health services system of care for children and youth in San Francisco.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**  
4 **accept and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the first year of**  
5 **a six year grant from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration**  
6 **(SAMHSA) to establish a comprehensive system of behavioral health services to**  
7 **children and youth in San Francisco and to enter into an agreement for the use of these**  
8 **funds; for the period of September 30, 2002 to September 29, 2003.**

10 WHEREAS, SFDPH was awarded a grant from SAMHSA to establish a comprehensive  
11 system of behavioral health services to children and youth in San Francisco; and,

12 WHEREAS, SAMHSA has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$1,000,000  
13 for the first year under the terms of this award; and,

14 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds SAMHSA requires SFDPH to enter  
15 into an agreement (“The Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
16 Supervisors in File No \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared to be a part of this  
17 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

18 WHEREAS, The SFDPH proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on  
19 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a  
21 grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 from SAMHSA; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
23 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the  
2 grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to San  
3 Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
5 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions  
7 created under the grant as "G" or grant-funded positions, which would terminate when the  
8 grant expires.
