AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION TO APPLY FOR AND ENTER INTO LOAN AGREEMENTS NOT TO EXCEED \$50 MILLION FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT OF PRIOR EXPENDITURES INCURRED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ISLAIS CREEK/RANKIN STREET TRANSPORT STORAGE FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, The State of California, acting through the State Water Resources Control Board ("SWRCB"), has appropriated funds and developed a program to provide revolving fund loans to municipal sewer agencies for the construction of sewage treatment works; and,

WHEREAS, The Public Utilities Commission has previously expended funds for the design and construction of the Islais Creek Transport/Storage Facilities ("Islais Creek Facilities") and the Rankin Street Pump Station/SEWPCP Improvements ("Rankin Street Facilities") and all works, property and structures incidental thereto in the central portion of the City; and,

WHEREAS, The Islais Creek Facilities and the Rankin Street Facilities capture, store and transport combined sewage to the Southeast Treatment Plant from the drainage areas in the central portion of the City, which has resulted in the enhancement, preservation and protection of the quality of water in the San Francisco Bay; and

WHEREAS, The Controller of the City has advised the Board of Supervisors that use of state revolving fund loans to reimburse prior expenditures incurred for the construction of the Islais Creek Facilities and the Rankin Street Facilities is the most cost-effective means of financing the project; and,

WHEREAS; The State of California, acting through SWRCB, is willing to loan to San Francisco up to \$50 million for reimbursement of prior expenditures made for the construction of the Islais Creek Facilities and the Rankin Street Facilities subject to availability of funds; and,

requested authorization pursuant to Charter Section 9.111-1 to apply for a state revolving fund loan (the "Loan") to assist in reimbursement of prior expenditures made for the construction of the Islais Creek Facilities and the Rankin Street Facilities; and WHEREAS, On November 4, 1994, the electorate of the City passed Proposition D

WHEREAS, The Public Utilities Commission, acting through its General Manager, has

WHEREAS, On November 4, 1994, the electorate of the City passed Proposition D authorizing the issuance of \$146 million of general purpose sewer revenue bonds (the "Approved Debt") to provide funds for acquiring, constructing, improving and financing additions, betterments and improvements to the existing municipal sewage treatment and disposal system, including, without limitation, flood control and major rehabilitation and upgrade of existing systems and facilities; and

WHEREAS, On June 29, 1995 the Public Utilities Commission issued its City and County of San Francisco Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series 1995A and Series 1995B (the "Series 1995 Bonds") in the aggregate principal amounts of \$44,230,000 and \$11,282,147.10, respectively, as a portion of the Approved Debt; and

WHEREAS, Acceptance of the Loan will allow the Public Utilities Commission to use revenues to retire or defease all or a portion of the Series 1995 Bonds; and

WHEREAS, Approximately 91 million dollars of the Approved Debt remains unissued; and

WHEREAS, The difference, if any, between the principal amount of the Loan and the principal amount of the Series 1995 Bonds defeased or retired will count against the Approved Debt; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of the Loan will not increase the amount of Approved Debt; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby finds and determines, that the use of Loan for reimbursement of construction expenses for the Islais Creek Facilities and the

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the General Manager, Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, City Attorney and City Controller are each hereby authorized and directed in the name and on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to take any and all steps to issue and deliver any and all certificates, requisitions, agreements, notices, consents, and other documents, which they or any of them might deem necessary or appropriate in order to consummate the lawful application for and acceptance and use of the Loan for the reimbursement of prior expenditures made for the construction of the Islais Creek Facilities and the Rankin Street Facilities.
