

1 [Resolution amending San Francisco’s CalWORKs County Plan – Cal-Learn]

3 **Resolution approving an amendment to San Francisco’s CalWORKs County Plan to**  
4 **allow the San Francisco Department of Human Services to directly provide Cal-Learn**  
5 **case management services to pregnant and parenting teens receiving Temporary Aid**  
6 **to Needy Families.**

8 WHEREAS, The Cal-Learn case management program provides comprehensive case  
9 management and supportive services to pregnant and parenting custodial teens who are  
10 receiving Temporary Aid to Needy Families (TANF) benefits, so that they can attend and  
11 graduate from high school and become self-sufficient adults and responsible parents; and

12 WHEREAS, The Cal-Learn case management services have been provided previously  
13 through a contract with Family Service Agency of San Francisco, and that contract expires on  
14 June 30, 2002; and

15 WHEREAS, The mission of the City and County of San Francisco Department of  
16 Human Services is to help people who are disadvantaged or in crisis obtain the resources  
17 they need to realize their human potential, within the context of family and community; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Department of Human Services has determined that it can best  
19 provide Cal-Learn case management services directly rather than through a contract; and

20 WHEREAS, The San Francisco County CalWORKs Plan, submitted to the California  
21 Department of Social Services on January 7, 1998, has been amended to reflect this change  
22 in the provision of Cal-Learn services; and

23 WHEREAS, The amended plan is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in  
24 File No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully  
25 herein; now, therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors accepts and approves this amendment to  
2 the San Francisco CalWORKs County Plan; and, be it

3           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Department of Human Services will  
4 submit the amended plan to the California Department of Social Services, for review and  
5 approval, pursuant to Section 10531 of the Welfare and Institutions Code required by The  
6 Welfare to Work Act of 1997, AB 1542; and, be it

7           FURTHER RESOLVED, That pending approval by the California Department of Social  
8 Services, the San Francisco Department of Human Services will begin providing Cal-Learn  
9 case management services directly on July 1, 2002.
