2 COMMENDING THE NATIONAL ASIAN PACIFIC CENTER ON AGING FOR ITS WORK  
3 WITH ASIAN AND PACIFIC ISLANDER ELDERS AND DECLARING APRIL 29, 1999,  
4 TO BE "ASIAN AND PACIFIC ISLANDER ELDERS DAY" IN SAN FRANCISCO.

5 WHEREAS, Asian and Pacific Islander seniors number close to  
6 100,000 in Alameda, Contra Costa, San Francisco, San Mateo, and Santa  
7 Clara Counties; and

8 WHEREAS, Asian and Pacific Islander seniors are among the  
9 fastest growing and most diverse minority ethnic group of elders in  
10 the Bay Area; and,

11 WHEREAS, Asian and Pacific Islander elders include many people  
12 who have made significant contributions to the economic and social  
13 growth of their communities, as well as many who are in great  
14 economic and social need; and,

15 WHEREAS, The National Asian Pacific Center on Aging is a  
16 nonprofit organization that advocates on behalf of Asian and Pacific  
17 Islander elders in the U.S.; and,

18 WHEREAS, Through its Community Capacity Building for Asian and  
19 Pacific Islander Elders project, NAPCA has worked with community,  
20 government and human service organizations to convene several  
21 meetings that involved over 500 elders in Bay Area counties in the  
22 last year; and,

23 WHEREAS, Capacity Building multi-lingual meetings have provided  
24 important opportunities for elders to speak directly about their  
25 experiences with language barriers, lack of access to information,

1 and inadequate resources that affect their ability to participate in  
2 existing programs and services; and,

3 WHEREAS, A Regional Conference on Asian and Pacific Islander  
4 elders is being convened on April 29, 1999, to identify actions that  
5 will improve service access, availability, and affordability for  
6 older Asian and Pacific Islander persons in the Bay Area; now,  
7 therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County  
9 of San Francisco commends the National Asian Pacific Center on Aging  
10 for its work with Asian and Pacific Islander seniors; and be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and  
12 County of San Francisco declares April 29, 1999, to be "Asian and  
13 Pacific Islander Elders Day" in San Francisco.




