[Southern Crossing]

Resolution urging the Metropolitan Transportation Commission to oppose plans for a Southern Crossing for automobile transit and to consider other transit alternatives for crossing the Bay.

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is currently considering a proposal to build another bridge for automobile transit connecting the East Bay to San Bruno with the intention of reducing traffic along the Peninsula; and,

WHEREAS, The proposal to build such a bridge was placed before voters in San Francisco, Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin and San Mateo Counties in 1972 and this proposal was voted down by more than a three to one margin giving an indication that residents of the Bay Area are opposed to this kind of proposal; and,

WHEREAS, When the MTC conducted a study ten years ago to determine whether a bridge like this one would benefit the area, they opted not to build considering the study's results; and,

WHEREAS, Paving over the Bay would continue the deterioration of the region's largest ecosystem and little evidence exists that traffic would be alleviated by a Southern Crossing over the Bay; and,

WHEREAS, Historic development of this kind has shown that expanding freeways for automobile use only encourages greater

automobile use and the problem of congestion continues to grow with the growing number of automobiles; and,

WHEREAS, There are alternatives to a bridge for automobiles that could accommodate the growing density of the Bay Area without contributing to greater air pollution or adding to the deterioration of the Bay; and,

WHEREAS, The MTC should consider alternatives such as the Dumbarton rail proposal which would connect San Francisco and the Peninsula with San Joaquin and Alameda Counties; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the Metropolitan Transportation Commission to oppose plans for a Southern Crossing for automobile transit and to consider other transit alternatives for crossing the Bay.
