

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Community Risk Reduction Plan - \$49,995]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health to accept and**
4 **expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$49,995 from the Bay Area Air Quality**
5 **Management District, to support a project entitled “Community Risk Reduction Plan”**
6 **for the period of July 1, 2010, through December 30, 2011.**

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8 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health is the recipient of a grant award from the
9 Bay Area Air Quality Management District to fund a project entitled “Community Risk
10 Reduction Plan (CRRP);” and,

11 WHEREAS, Through this grant, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District has
12 agreed to fund DPH in the amount of \$49,995 the period of July 1, 2010 through December
13 30, 2011; and,

14 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the Bay Area Air Quality
15 Management District requires the City to enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of
16 which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____; which
17 is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

18 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH
19 for one existing position, Epidemiologist I (Job Class #2802) at 0.65 FTE; and,

20 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not
21 receive notification of the Agreement until July 19, 2010 for a project start date of July 1, 2010;
22 and,

23 WHEREAS, The budget does not include a provision for indirect costs as it is not
24 allowed by the granting agency; now therefore, be it

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1 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant retroactively
2 in the amount of \$49,995 from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
4 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
5 be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
7 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
9 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions
11 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
12 the agreement expires.
