WHEREAS, The City owns real property located in Hayes Valley known as "Koshland Park," which is under the jurisdiction of the Recreation and Park Department; and,

WHEREAS, The Hayes Valley Neighborhood Parks Group ("HVNGP") is a community-based advocacy group for parks in the Hayes Valley neighborhood, including Koshland Park; and,

WHEREAS, The HVNPG is proposing to install a collection of approximately 2,000 - 6" square tiles to beautify a retaining wall along Page Street at Koshland Park as a gift-in-place to the City; and,

WHEREAS, Through a series of workshops conducted by HVNPG, members of various organizations representing a diversity of people, including schools, churches, community-based organizations and youth-serving agencies, painted the aforementioned collection of tiles; and,

WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission recommends to the Board of Supervisors to accept and expend the Gift as Resolution Number 0207-011, July 18, 2002; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the General Manager of the Recreation and Park Department to accept the gift-in-place valued at approximately \$60,000 from the Hayes Valley Neighborhood Parks Group for Koshland Park.
