ORDINANCE NO. 200-89

(Street Vacation)

1 ORDERING VACATION OF A PORTION OF CRESCENT AVENUE WESTERLY OF ALEMANY
2 BOULEVARD, AND ADOPTING FINDINGS PURSUANT TO CITY PLANNING CODE SECTION
3 101.1.

5 Be It Ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

6 Section 1. On April 24 , 1989, the Board of Supervisors adopted
7 Resolution No. 303-89 , approved by the Mayor on April 26, 1989 ,
8 being a Resolution of A Declaration of Intention to order the vacation
9 of Crescent Avenue as shown on Department of Public Works' Drawing No.
10 SUR-988, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the
11 Board of Supervisors.

12 Section 2. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors did transmit to
13 the Director of Public Works a certified copy of said Resolution, and
14 the Director of Public Works did cause to be posted in the manner
15 required by law, notice of the passage of said Resolution.

16 Section 3. When said matter was considered as scheduled by the
17 Board of Supervisors at its regular meeting held in the City Hall, San
18 Francisco, on May 30, 1989 , beginning at 7³:00 P.M., said Board
19 heard all persons interested in said vacation.

20 Section 4. The public interest and convenience require the vacation
21 to be done as declared in said Resolution No. 303-89.

22 Section 5. The Department of City Planning reported on September 2,
23 1988 that said vacation is in conformity with the Master Plan and con-
24 sistent with the eight priority policies of City Planning Code Section
25 101.1.


26 Section 6. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorpor-
27 ates by reference herein, as though fully set forth, the findings made
28 by the Department of City Planning, by its letter dated September 2, 1988,
29 that the vacation of said portion of Crescent Avenue is consistent with
30 the eight priority policies of City Planning Code Section 101.1.

1 Section 7. The Board of Supervisors has acquired jurisdiction to
2 order said vacation subject to the conditions as set forth in the
3 Declaration of Intention to order the said vacation.

4 Section 8. The said portion of Crescent Avenue is hereby ordered
5 vacated and the underlying fee title retained by the City and County of
6 San Francisco.


7 Section 9. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby directed


