12	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

14	Section 1. Article XIX of Chapter 5 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by		
15	revising Sections 5.19-6, 5.19-7, and 5.19.8, to read as follows:		
16	SEC. 5.19-6. FAMILY VIOLENCE COUNCIL – ORGANIZATION.		
17	(a) Removal of Council Members. If a member of the Council appointed by the		
18	Steering Committee misses three regularly scheduled meetings of the Council in any 12-		
19	month period without the express approval of the Council, the Steering Committee may		
20	appoint a new member to fill his/her that seat on the Council. If a member in seats 1 through		
21	248 on the Council who has been designated by the named member to fill the seat misses		
22	three regularly scheduled meetings of the Council in any 12-month period without the express		
23	approval of the Council, the Steering Committee may ask the named member to designate		
24	another individual to occupy that seat.		

SEC. 5.19-7. FAMILY VIOLENCE COUNCIL AND STEERING COMMITTEE – SUPPORT, STAFFING, AND ASSISTANCE.

(a) The Department on the Status of Women shall The Mayor shall designate a City department to provide support to the Council and the Steering Committee in scheduling meetings, developing meeting agendas, and performing such other functions as are necessary to promote the work of the Council.

* * * *

SEC. 5.19-8. FAMILY VIOLENCE COUNCIL - SUNSET.

Unless the Board of Supervisors by ordinance extends the term of the Family Violence Council, this Article XIX shall expire by operation of law, and the Council shall terminate, on May 1, 202427. After that date, the City Attorney *shall is authorized to* cause this Article to be removed from the Administrative Code.

Section 2. Interim Seat Retention.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Administrative Code Sections 5.19-5 and 5.19-6, all members serving on the Family Violence Council as of May 1, 2024 shall retain their seats until the effective date of this ordinance. Following the effective date of this ordinance, they shall continue to retain their seats until the designated end date of their terms, as applicable, or are removed according to Administrative Code Sections 5.19-5 and 5.19-6, as applicable, or resign. This Section 2 shall not override any ordinance that amends provisions of Administrative Code Chapter 5, Article XIX, regarding membership on the Family Violence Council.

1	Section 3. Effective Date; Retroactivity.
2	(a) This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs
3	when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not
4	sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the
5	Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
6	(b) Upon its effective date, this ordinance shall be retroactive to May 1, 2024.
7	(c) It is the intent of the Board of Supervisors that the Family Violence Council
8	continue to operate in the interim period from May 1, 2024 to the effective date of this
9	ordinance.
10	
11	Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
12	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
13	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
14	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
15	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
16	the official title of the ordinance. By making this ordinance retroactive to May 1, 2024, the text
17	of Administrative Code Chapter 5, Article XIX in effect as of April 30, 2024 will be unchanged
18	except as amended by this ordinance or any other ordinance.

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Family Violence Council]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to extend the sunset date of the Family Violence Council to May 1, 2027 and allow the Mayor to select a City department to provide administrative support to the council; and update the text to reflect prior changes in membership of the Council.

Existing Law

The Family Violence Council ("Council") is scheduled to sunset on May 1, 2024. Existing law requires the Department on the Status of Women to provide the Council administrative support.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would extend the sunset date of the Council to May 1, 2027. The ordinance would allow the Mayor to designate a "City department," instead of the Department on the Status of Women, to provide the Council support.

Background Information

The Council was established to advise and submit recommendations to the Board of Supervisors that address the problems of family violence, such as child abuse, domestic violence, and elder/dependent adult abuse.
