10 incarcerated women, the Sheriff's Department will offer a program to encourage family literacy,  
11 improve skills and use learning as a means of family reunification for incarcerated women and  
12 their children while in custody; and,

13 WHEREAS, The grant does not require matching funds; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department proposes to maximize use of available grant  
15 funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,  
16 therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in  
18 the grant budget; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That a grant award notification has been received from the  
20 Zellerbach Family Foundation; and, be it


