

Black Californian's **account for 28% of the prison population but less than 6% of California's overall population***.

Californian's Incarcerated in Prison are Paid*:

- Traditionally between \$.08 and \$.95 cents per hour
- Those fighting California's wildfires earn between \$2 and \$5 ***a day*** plus \$1 an hour when on a fire

California's spends about **\$13 billion annually on Corrections**.
This represents 7% of the state budget.

California Prison Industry Authority (CALPIA)
oversees roughly **7000 incarcerated workers in California**.

- Fabric manufacturing alone brought in revenue of \$23.7 million in 2019
- As of August 2020, 83 percent of prisoners that staffed the furniture factory at Avenal State Prison had contracted COVID-19.
