RESOLUTION NO. 264-99

1 [1999-2000 Children's Services Plan]

2 APPROVING THE CHILDREN'S SERVICES PLAN FOR THE SAN FRANCISCO CHILDREN'S FUND IN
3 ACCORDANCE WITH CHARTER SECTION 16.108

4 WHEREAS, In November 1991 the voters of San Francisco enacted a charter amendment which
5 established the San Francisco Children's Fund; and

6 WHEREAS, The provision of this section requires that the City revenues set aside for the fund be
7 used exclusively to provide services to children, less than 18 years of age, above and beyond services
8 funded prior to the adoption of the amendment; and

9 WHEREAS, This section further requires the Health Commission, Juvenile Probation Commission,
10 Human Services Commission, Public Library Commission and Recreation and Parks Commission to hold
11 public hearings on the Plan and those hearings were or will be held March 2, 1999, February 24, 1999,
12 February 25, 1999, March 2, 1999; and February 18, 1999, respectively; and

13 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors provides important oversight for the Children's Services
14 Fund, and is acutely aware that accountability to the public is of critical importance in a fund that was
15 created by the voters; and

16 WHEREAS, In accordance with Charter Section 16.108, the Mayor has submitted a Children's
17 Services Plan that proposes goals and objectives for the Fund, and designates City Departments for the
18 administration of the Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999; now therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approve the 1999-2000 Children's Services Plan
20 submitted by the Mayor in accordance with Charter Section 16.108. a copy of which is on file
21 at the Board of Supervisors; and, be it

22 mlr 23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That on or about July 15, 1999, the Department of
24 Children, Youth and Their Families submit a detailed budget supporting the \$700,000
25 allocation for evaluation services, including the identification of all outside
consultants and nonprofit agencies, the amount allocated to each specific organiza-
tion, the estimated hours of service to be provided, and the average hourly rates
to be charged by each organization.


