1 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE COUNCIL (MCJC) TO ACCEPT AND
2 EXPEND FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$546,177 FROM THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE
3 PLANNING (OCJP), STATE OF CALIFORNIA, FROM FUNDS MADE AVAILABLE UNDER THE
4 JUVENILE ACCOUNTABILITY INCENTIVE BLOCK GRANT (JAIBG).


5 WHEREAS the Mayor's Criminal Justice Council desires to undertake a certain project
6 designated, Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant, to be funded in part from funds made available
7 through the JAIBG Program administered by the Office of Criminal Justice Planning (hereafter referred to
8 as OCJP).


9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of the Mayor's Criminal Justice
10 Council is authorized, on its behalf to submit the attached proposal to OCJP and is authorized to sign and
11 approve on behalf of City and the County of San Francisco the attached Grant Award Agreement including
12 any extensions or amendments thereof.


13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the applicant agrees to provide all matching funds required
14 for said project (including any amendment thereof) under the Program and the funding terms and
15 conditions of OCJP and that the cash match will be appropriated as required.

16 IT IS AGREED that any liability out of the performance of this Grant Award Agreement,
17 including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the
18 authorizing agency. The State of California and OCJP disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant
20 expenditures controlled by this body.


