4 **arrest and conviction of the perpetrator who murdered Willie Allen.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. In or about March 2008, Mayor Gavin Newsom authorized a reward of \$250,000 for
11 information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect or suspects responsible for the April 4, 2006
12 murder of Willie Allen. Doe One came forward and supplied information leading to the identification, arrest and
13 conviction of the person responsible for the murder of Mr. Allen. The San Francisco Police Department and San
14 Francisco District Attorney’s Office have confirmed that Doe One provided investigators with information that
15 lead to the identity of the suspect responsible for the murder, and that Doe One assisted in the successful
16 prosecution of the case, resulting in the suspect pleading guilty to the crime and being sentence to state prison in
17 2012.

18 Section 2. The Controller of the City and County of San Francisco is hereby authorized to draft a warrant
19 upon the Treasury of the City and County of San Francisco in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand
20 Dollars (\$250,000) payable to Doe One for supplying information leading to the arrest and conviction of the
21 perpetrator who murdered Willie Allen.
