12 California's Coast, and

13 WHEREAS, Sail San Francisco 2002 attracted more than one million persons to the
14 waterfront of the San Francisco Bay; and

16 WHEREAS, Sail San Francisco 2002 provided public access to our urban coastline for
17 recreational and educational purposes; and,

18 WHEREAS, Sail San Francisco 2002 provided educational maritime programming for
19 over 1,000 underprivileged children and youth from local communities; and,

20 WHEREAS, Sail San Francisco's programming is focused on encouraging public use
21 urban open-space and outdoor recreation areas, including an annual waterfront event
22 including multi-cultural music and dance, maritime career fair and maritime activities; and,

24 WHEREAS, Sail San Francisco endeavors to provide an international event featuring
25 historic sailing ships every three years; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors commends the State of
2 California Coastal Conservancy for its generous support of Sail San Francisco 2002, and be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Board of Supervisors respectfully
4 encourages the Coastal Conservancy's continued support of the Sail San Francisco's future
5 programming for the benefit of residents and visitors of San Francisco.


