AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE COUNCIL TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$474,961 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION (OJJDP), TO SUPPORT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMPREHENSIVE EFFORT TO REFORM THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO'S JUVENILE JUSTICE SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, OJJDP is the agency within the U.S. Department of Justice that provides grants to local and state governments across the nation to support innovative programs for juvenile justice and delinquency prevention; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 1999 the OJJDP awarded San Francisco's Mayor's Criminal Justice Council a grant of \$750,000 for fiscal year 1999 - 2000 to support program activities of the Mayor's Juvenile Justice Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, in the 1999 - 2000 annual appropriation budget process for the City and County of San Francisco, \$275,039 of the \$750,000 awarded was budgeted and approved by the Board of Supervisors through the annual budget process; and,

WHEREAS, the project period of this grant award is from July 1, 1998 to October 31, 2001, and funds will be renewable each fiscal year contingent on federal appropriations; and,

WHEREAS, the entire award by OJJDP of the U.S. Department of Justice funds direct services, it is requested that indirect costs be waived; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes the Director of the Mayor's Criminal Justice Council to accept and expend \$474,961 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention in support of the Mayor's Juvenile Justice Action Plan.
