WHEREAS, There is an urgent need to protect our country's historic and natural heritage; and,

WHEREAS, In 1965, Congress created the Land and Water Conservation Fund, which would provide 900 million dollars for environmental and conservation efforts; and,

WHEREAS, For more than thirty years, Congress has stalled on the commitment they made to ensure that these funds would be used to preserve our endangered and valuable resources; and,

WHEREAS, The Permanent Protection for America's Resources 2000 Act, authored by U.S. Senator Barbara Boxer and U.S. Representative George Miller, would set aside 2.3 billion dollars annually in offshore drilling revenue to protect the nation's most endangered lands, wetlands and wildlife; and,

WHEREAS, this bill would set an immediate course of action to rescue our natural and historic treasures from endangerment or extinction; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco supports the legislation introduced by U.S. Senator Barbara Boxer and U.S. Representative George Miller to use offshore oil resource funding to protect and maintain America's lands, parks and water resources.
