

1 [Accept-Expend Federal Grant – Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of the District Attorney of the City and County**
4 **of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$95,033**
5 **through the California Department of Justice for a program entitled “Spousal Abuser**
6 **Prosecution Program” for fiscal year 2005/2006.**

8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to continue a certain project
9 designated the Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program to be funded in part from funds made
10 available through the California Department of Justice (hereafter “DOJ”); and,

11 WHEREAS, DOJ requires that the City and County of San Francisco, through the
12 Office of the District Attorney, provide no less than a twenty percent cash match for the grant;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, The terms of the grant prohibit inclusion of indirect costs in the grant
15 budget; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney of
17 the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend funds from DOJ for
18 the purposes of spousal abuser prosecution; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
20 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of
22 the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreements for spousal
23 abuser prosecution purposes, including any extensions, augmentations or amendments
24 thereof; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized and empowered to
2 execute, deliver and perform, in the name of the City and County of San Francisco, all
3 applications, contracts, agreements, amendments and payment requests necessary for the
4 purpose of securing Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program grant funds and to implement and
5 carry out the purposes specified in the applicable grant application; and be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant
7 Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the
8 grant recipient and the authorizing agency; and be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to
10 supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
