3 **Resolution authorizing the Police Department to retroactively accept and expend a**
4 **California State Department of Boating and Waterways grant in the amount of \$73,000**
5 **for a Boating Safety and Enforcement grant to purchase equipment for the Marine Unit.**

7 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department applied for and was awarded
8 \$73,000 in funding from the California State Department of Boating and Waterways for a
9 Boating and Safety Enforcement grant; and

10 WHEREAS, The purpose of the grant is to support enforcement activities through the
11 purchase and installation of 8 shock-mitigating seats and an inflatable sponson; and

12 WHEREAS, The award period is from November 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, The grant does not include any provision for indirect costs; and

15 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department is seeking retroactive approval
16 because it did not receive the grant award until November 1, 2011; and

17 WHEREAS, This grant does not create any new positions, and will not require an
18 amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; now therefore be it

19 **RESOLVED** The City and County of San Francisco is authorized to retroactively accept
20 and expend a grant from the California State Department of Boating and Waterways in the
21 amount of \$73,000; and be it

22 **FURTHER RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
23 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police, or his designee, is authorized to
2 enter into the agreement on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco.
