Resolution retroactively approving the contract between the City and County of San Francisco and the IHSS Consortium of San Francisco for the provision of In-Home Supportive Services for the period from July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2008, in the amount of \$51,433,291.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco wishes to provide contract mode In-Home Supportive Services to eligible blind, aged, and disabled persons to enable these individuals to remain safely in their homes; and,

WHEREAS, The Human Services Agency conducted a Request for Proposal for these services in January 2005; and,

WHEREAS, The IHSS Consortium of San Francisco submitted a responsive and responsible proposal and was awarded the contract; and

WHEREAS, The Human Services Commission has recommended approval of this contract to the IHSS Consortium of San Francisco at its meeting of June 10, 2005; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby retroactively approves award of this contract to the IHSS Consortium of San Francisco for the period of July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2008, in the amount of \$51,433,291.
