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3 **Resolution approving the settlement of the unlitigated claim filed by SF Vertigo LLC**  
4 **against the City and County of San Francisco by payment of \$3,367,576; the claim was**  
5 **filed on November 16, 2022; the claim involves allegations of property damage to the**  
6 **Hotel Vertigo caused by shelter-in-place (SIP) hotel guests during the COVID-19**  
7 **pandemic and resulting loss of use; other material terms of the settlement include a**  
8 **mutual full and final release, with each party to bear their own costs.**

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10 WHEREAS, SF Vertigo LLC, a California limited liability company, filed a claim on  
11 November 16, 2022, against the City and County of San Francisco; and

12 WHEREAS, The claim involves allegations of property damage to the Hotel Vertigo  
13 caused by shelter-in-place (SIP) hotel guests during the COVID-19 pandemic and resulting  
14 loss of use; and

15 WHEREAS, The Human Services Agency has recommended settlement of the claim  
16 by payment of \$3,367,576, and other material terms of the settlement include a mutual full  
17 and final release, with each party to bear their own costs; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.22, the Board of  
19 Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle and compromise the claim by  
20 payment of \$3,367,576, and other material terms of the settlement include a mutual full and  
21 final release, with each party to bear their own costs.

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
