Business and/or professional experience:



Additionally, I am responsible for analysis and management of complex capital project funding plans, advocacy, and stakeholder relationships.

I am currently an alternate member of the Caltrain Citizen's Advisory Council, having been appointed by the Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board August 5, 2020. I represent the City and County of San Francisco.
