3 **Resolution authorizing the Chief of Police for the City and County of San Francisco to**
4 **accept and expend grant funds made available through the California Office of traffic**
5 **Safety, a State agency, for a project entitled "California Seat belt Compliance**
6 **Campaign".**

8 WHEREAS, The Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco desires to
9 undertake a certain project designated California Seat Belt Compliance Campaign (CSBCC),
10 to be funded from funds made available through the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS),
11 a State agency; and,

12 WHEREAS, The CSBCC goal is to increase seat belt use statewide to 94 percent in
13 2005 through the combined efforts of the California Highway Patrol (CHP), OTS and local law
14 enforcement during the May 2005 Buckle Up America/Operation ABC National Mobilization;
15 and,

16 WHEREAS, This grant will offset overtime and reporting costs for seat belt
17 enforcement during a three week (May 16 through June 5, 2005) mobilization period that
18 includes the Memorial Day Holiday; and,

19 WHEREAS, the grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,
20 therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in
22 the grant budget; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and County of San
24 Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively


1 accept and expend continued funding for this project from the California Office of Traffic

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising out of the grantees
8 performance of this Grant Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the
9 responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency; and be it


10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to


