

1 [Grant to support the SF Child Injury Prevention Program.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), to**
4 **retroactively accept and expend funds from the Kids' Plates Program, San Diego State**
5 **University Research Foundation in the amount of \$54,000 in support of SF Child Injury**
6 **Prevention Program, for the period of October 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.**

8 WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant from the Kids' Plates Program, San Diego
9 State University Research Foundation to fund the San Francisco Child Injury Prevention
10 Program, for the period of October 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008; and

11 WHEREAS, The grant was awarded for three fiscal years, for a total amount of
12 \$192,000, with funding for years two and three (fiscal years 2008-09 and 2009-10) contingent
13 on satisfactory performance and completion of prior year objectives; and,

14 WHEREAS, Funds will be used to improve child safety in San Francisco by
15 establishing a coordinated, multidisciplinary Child Injury Prevention Program in DPH; and,

16 WHEREAS, DPH was not notified of the award until September 27, 2007 with the
17 provision that the start date be October 1, 2007, hence the retroactive request; and,

18 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, Kids' Plates Program, San
19 Diego State University Research Foundation requires the City to enter into an agreement (the
20 "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File
21 No. 071517; which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth
22 fully herein; and,

23 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of
24 \$7,627 for FY 2007-08; and,

1 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses the
2 department for one existing position, Health Educator (Job Class #2822) at .50 FTE; and also
3 includes a Public Service Aide (Job Class #9924) for 208 hours in FY 2007-08 which is a
4 temporary, non-benefited intern position; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant
6 in the amount of \$54,000 from the Kids' Plates Program, San Diego State University
7 Research Foundation; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
9 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
10 be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
12 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions
14 funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when
15 the agreement expires.
