3 **Resolution urging support for the Museum of the African Diaspora by the**  
4 **California Cultural and Historical Endowment.**

6 WHEREAS, The Museum of the African Diaspora ("Museum") will be a world class  
7 museum that utilizes the art, culture, and history of individuals of African heritage in California  
8 and worldwide; and

9 WHEREAS, The Museum's mission is to connect all people through understanding the  
10 culture and history of the African Diaspora; and,

11 WHEREAS, Planning for the Museum began in 2001, involving dozens of local and  
12 nationally known scholars and community leaders as well as cultural institutional  
13 management, architectural, and design contractors to ensure the Museum's success; and,

14 WHEREAS, Construction to build the museum is slated to start in December, 2004;  
15 and,

16 WHEREAS, The Museum is securing funds to build the exhibition, education, and  
17 public events spaces of the new facility; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Museum has received funding to support these projects from the  
19 Redevelopment Agency, Hewlett Packard, Carpenter & Carpenter Foundation, and is  
20 applying for funds from the California Cultural and Historical Endowment; and,

21 WHEREAS, These funds will be used to build a Celebrations Immersive Theater, and  
22 Exhibit on Slavery, a Human Timeline, an active photographic Diaspora Mosaic mural, and a  
23 Freedom – Decision Theater; and,
