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3	Motion directing the Budget Analyst to assess the cost per person to residents of San
4	Francisco if voters approve Proposition O on the November ballot.
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6	WHEREAS, Proposition O is an initiative ordinance on the November 2002 ballot which
7	would direct the City to create and fund certain services and programs to serve the homeless;
8	and,
9	WHEREAS, It is uncertain what the true total costs and the costs per capita to
10	residents of the City may be if Proposition O passes; and
11	WHEREAS, Information on the impacts of the initiative is crucial to the ability of voters
12	to make an informed decision on whether to support or oppose Proposition O; now, therefore,
13	be it
14	MOVED, That the Budget Analyst of the San Francisco Board of Supervisors is
15	directed to perform an analysis of the estimated cost per person to San Francisco residents if
16	Proposition O on the November ballot is passed by the voters; and be it,
17	FURTHER MOVED, That this analysis should also consider possible sources of
18	revenue to fund services which would be required under Proposition O, including state and
19	federal revenue, as well as existing sources of revenue currently being used to fund programs
20	used by the homeless, so that the Budget Analyst may estimate the likely impact of
21	Proposition O on the City's General Fund.
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
