SUBJECT: Retroactive Accept and Expend Resolution for Subject Grant

GRANT TITLE: U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Grant

This memo provides background information on the retroactive grant legislation. The legislation is retroactive because the Recreation and Park Department (RPD) accepted the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA Cooperative Agreement for a \$2,000,000 grant prior to obtaining Board of Supervisors approval, as required under Administrative Code Section 9.118.

Background

On August 18, 2025, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) awarded RPD a \$2,000,000 Brownfield Grant. Upon issuance of any grant award, USEPA requires the awardee to either accept the terms of the Cooperative Agreement within 21-days or submit a notice of disagreement.

Upon receipt of the award notification, the City Attorney's Office reviewed the Cooperative Agreement's terms and conditions and requested further clarification of certain terms. After receiving clarification on specific provisions, the City Attorney's Office recommended that RPD proceed with accepting the agreement in order to secure the funding.

The Cooperative Agreement performance period commenced on October 1, 2025, coinciding with the start of the federal fiscal year. Although the agreement is currently active, no grant funds have been expended to date.

Because the Cooperative Agreement start date is prior to Board approval, the associated grant legislation is retroactive.
