3 **Resolution urging the Mayor to build a citywide response to end domestic violence by**
4 **raising the reward for apprehending Tari Ramirez from \$35,000 to \$50,000.**

6 WHEREAS, On October 22, 2000, victim Claire Tempongko was stabbed to death in
7 front of her 5-year-old daughter and 10-year-old son at her residence by suspect, Tari
8 Ramirez during an ongoing domestic violence dispute; and,

9 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department holds an arrest warrant for suspect
10 Tari Ramirez; and,

11 WHEREAS, Suspect Tari Ramirez has been at large since October 2000; and,

12 WHEREAS, The current reward is set at \$35,000; and,

13 WHEREAS, The City will be able to significantly increase the incentive for
14 apprehending suspect Tari Ramirez by raising the reward to \$50,000; and,

15 WHEREAS, In raising the reward to \$50,000, San Francisco will take a step towards
16 finding suspect Tari Ramirez and bringing him to justice; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Mayor to build a citywide
18 response to end domestic violence by raising the reward for apprehending Tari Ramirez from
19 \$35,000 to \$50,000.


