14	Assistance Grant (JAG) Equipment and Training Program to support the Criminology	
15	Laboratory; and	
16	WHEREAS, The BSCC that provides grant funds to the SFPD requires	
17	documentation of the Board's approval of their specific grant funds (Edward Byrne	
18	Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Equipment and Training Program); and	
19	WHEREAS, On September 24, 2025, the BSCC approved SFPD's application	
20	and awarded a grant in the amount of \$654,609 for the procurement of equipment and	
21	services for the Criminology Laboratory for the project period beginning October 1,	
22	2025, through September 30, 2026; and	
23	WHEREAS, The SFPD proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on	
24	program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore,

1	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors retroactively authorizes the SFPD to
2	accept and expend the grant award of \$654,609 from the BSCC; and, be it
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion
4	of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it
5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Chief of
6	Police, or his designee, to enter into agreement on behalf of the City and County of San
7	Francisco, as well as execute extensions and amendments for this grant; and, be it
8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the agreement being fully
9	executed by all parties, the Police Department shall provide the final agreement to the Clerk of
10	the Board for inclusion into the official file.
