

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - Board of State and Community Corrections - JAG
2 Equipment and Training Program - \$654,609]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Police Department to accept and expend a**
4 **grant in the amount of \$654,609 from the Board of State and Community Corrections**
5 **for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Equipment and**
6 **Training Program to procure equipment and services for the Criminology Laboratory**
7 **with the project period beginning on October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2026.**

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9 WHEREAS, The Administrative Code requires City departments to obtain Board of
10 Supervisors' approval to accept or expend any grant funds; and

11 WHEREAS, The Police Department (SFPD) applied for funding from the Board of
12 State and Community Corrections (BSCC) under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice
13 Assistance Grant (JAG) Equipment and Training Program to support the Criminology
14 Laboratory; and

15 WHEREAS, The BSCC that provides grant funds to the SFPD requires
16 documentation of the Board's approval of their specific grant funds (Edward Byrne
17 Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Equipment and Training Program); and

18 WHEREAS, On September 24, 2025, the BSCC approved SFPD's application and
19 awarded a grant in the amount of \$654,609 for the procurement of equipment and services
20 for the Criminology Laboratory for the project period beginning October 1, 2025, through
21 September 30, 2026; and

22 WHEREAS, The SFPD proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on
23 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be
24 it

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1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors retroactively authorizes the SFPD to
2 accept and expend the grant award of \$654,609 from the BSCC; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
4 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Chief of
6 Police, or his designee, to enter into agreement on behalf of the City and County of San
7 Francisco, as well as execute extensions and amendments for this grant; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the agreement being fully
9 executed by all parties, the Police Department shall provide the final agreement to the Clerk of
10 the Board for inclusion into the official file.
