3 \$82,196 GRANT FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE TWIN PEAKS TRAIL FROM THE

6 WHEREAS, The State of California Department of Parks and  
7 Recreation has awarded a grant for the project shown above; and

8 WHEREAS, The State Department of Parks and Recreation has been  
9 delegated the responsibility for the administration of these grant  
10 projects, setting up necessary procedures; and

11 WHEREAS, Said procedures established by the State Department of  
12 Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution  
13 the approval of application for the above projects before submission  
14 of said application to the state; and

17 WHEREAS, The applicant will enter into an agreement with the  
18 State of California for the subject projects; and

19 WHEREAS, Indirect costs are not allowed by the funder; now,  
20 therefore be it

21 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of

- 1 1. Approves the application, acceptance and expenditure of  
2 \$82,196 for the rehabilitation of trails on Twin Peaks;
- 3 2. Certifies that the City and County of San Francisco  
4 Recreation and Park Department is in accordance with the  
5 general provisions of the agreement with the State of  
6 California;
- 7  
8 3. Certifies that the City and County of San Francisco has  
9 sufficient funds to operate and maintain projects funded  
10 under this program;
- 11 4. Certifies that said agency has reviewed and understands the  
12 General Provision contained in the State/local agreement  
13 shown in the Procedural Guide;
- 14  
15 5. Appoints the General Manager or Acting General Manager as  
16 agent of the Recreation and Park Department to conduct all  
17 negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including  
18 but not limited to, applications, agreements, payment  
19 requests and so on, which may be necessary for the  
20 completion of the aforementioned projects; and

- 22 6. Waives indirect costs as they are not allowed by the Funder.


