2 RECOGNIZING THE SURVEY "NORTH BEACH, SAN FRANCISCO: AN ARCHITECTURAL,
3 HISTORICAL CULTURAL SURVEY" AS A COMPREHENSIVE RECORD OF THE
4 HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL RESOURCES IN NORTH BEACH.

6 WHEREAS, A survey of the historic resources of North Beach was completed in 1982
7 and the results published in a 2-volume report entitled "North Beach, San Francisco: An
8 Architectural, Historical Cultural Survey" ("North Beach Survey"); and

9 WHEREAS, The North Beach Survey is the product of a federal grant pursuant to the
10 National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and was carried out under a formal contract with
11 the California State Office of Historic Preservation ("OHP") and as such, produced survey
12 findings meeting both state and federal guidelines established by the OHP and the National
13 Park Service; the final survey results were reviewed and approved by OHP and incorporated
14 into the California Historical Resources Inventory System, the official compilation of
15 all identified and evaluated historical resources in California; and

16 WHEREAS, The North Beach Survey was conducted with the support of the Planning
17 Commission, the Director of the Planning Department, the Office of the Mayor and the
18 Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board by architectural historians meeting the Secretary of
19 the Interior's Professional Qualifications; and

20 WHEREAS, The California State Office of Historic Preservation and the Foundation for
21 San Francisco's Architectural Heritage have urged the Board of Supervisors to recognize the
22 North Beach Survey; and

23 WHEREAS, The North Beach Survey is the most comprehensive record of the
24 historical and architectural resources in North Beach available and is an important addition to
25

1 previously recognized historical and architectural surveys of the City's resources; now,
2 therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby recognize and accept the
4 North Beach Survey as a comprehensive record of the historical and architectural resources
5 in North Beach; and be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That, recognizing the value of this survey effort to the local
7 planning process, the Board of Supervisors hereby encourages local neighborhood
8 associations and preservation groups in their ongoing efforts to update and expand the North
9 Beach Survey; and be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board transmit a copy of this resolution
11 to the Department of Planning and the Landmarks Advisory Preservation Board in a timely
12 manner; and be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby recognizes and
14 accepts subsequent updates and revisions which are completed within six (6)
15 months of adoption of this resolution.




