WHEREAS, Lake Merced is an important natural resource for San Francisco and the entire Bay Area; and,

WHEREAS, Lake Merced is a recreational resource for families to enjoy boating, fishing, bird watching, jogging, golf, picnicking, and many other activities; and,

WHEREAS, For generations, Lake Merced has been the only fishing lake in San Francisco, and,

WHEREAS, Lake Merced is also an important source of water for the City in the event of an emergency; and,

WHEREAS, Water levels at Lake Merced have decreased over the past several decades for a number of reasons; and,

WHEREAS, Lakeside conditions are also in decline as litter is going uncollected, vandalism and graffiti are on the rise, rest rooms are in disrepair, and the children's fishing pier has been rendered unusable; and,

WHEREAS, A group of stakeholders, including the Friends of Lake Merced, San Francisco Beautiful, San Francisco State University, the Public Utilities Commission, and the Recreation and Parks Department,

have come together to initiate a Task Force to address the problems at Lake Merced; and,

WHEREAS, The mission of the Task Force is to build upon existing plans, policies, and programs, implementing short-term actions while creating a long-term, sustainable program for the stewardship of Lake Merced; and,

WHEREAS, The Task Force is working to develop a framework within which the Lake's many stakeholders can communicate and cooperate in a united effort to develop Lake Merced as a natural, aesthetic, recreational, and educational resource; and,

WHEREAS, The Task Force, through a Memorandum of Understanding, has invited many stakeholders to participate in its work, including government agencies and legislative offices with jurisdiction over Lake Merced, educational institutions, recreational interest groups, neighborhood and homeowners groups, environmental and community groups, philanthropic organizations, concessionaires, and neighbors; and,

WHEREAS, The first meeting of the Lake Merced Task Force will take place in January 2000; now therefore be it,

RESOVLED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby endorses the work of the Lake Merced Task Force; and be it,
