3	Resolution urging the Department of Parking and Traffic to remove 3 parking
4	spaces on the south side of Fell Street at the intersection of Fell and Masonic
5	Avenue to create a 50 foot no parking zone, enabling greater visibility of cyclists
6	and pedestrians as motorists turn left
7	
8	WHEREAS, There have been 23 reported collisions over the past four years at the
9	intersection of Fell and Masonic, and at least 5 bicyclists have been hit by motor
10	vehicles according to records kept by the Department of Parking and Traffic; and
11	WHEREAS, It is a goal of the City and County of San Francisco to provide a safe
12	and continuous bicycle and pedestrian network to destinations throughout the City; and
13	WHEREAS, The Panhandle Pathway was recently repaved and widened thanks to
14	the diligent efforts of Peter Tannen and the rest of the City's Bicycle Program, resulting
15	in increased use by bicyclists, pedestrians, and in-line skaters at the Fell and Masonic
16	intersection; and
17	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors lauds the efforts of
18	volunteers with the San Francisco Bicycle Coalition and Walk San Francisco who have
19	been acting as crossing guards to safely escort cyclists and pedestrians across this
20	hazardous intersection in the interim before a dedicated signal phase can be
21	established; and
22	WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic has identified interim
23	measures to increase public safety immediately and these have been funded by the
24	Transportation Authority, including crosswalk repainting, an advance phase for

pedestrians and cyclists, an advance stop, as well as further improvements that have

1	been identified and may be implemented in a second phase of this project in the near
2	future; and
3	WHEREAS, Public comment during the Bicycle Plan Update community outreach
4	process favored implementation of two separate signal phases: one for traffic turning
5	left from Fell onto Masonic and one for Panhandle non-motorized traffic; and
6	WHEREAS, The three parking spaces in question, when occupied, obstruct
7	visibility of approaching cyclists and pedestrians when a vehicle is turning left; and
8	WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic has agreed that removal of the
9	3 parking spaces in question is necessary and will increase visibility and safety;
10	therefore be it
11	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Department of Parking and
12	Traffic to remove the 3 parking spaces on the south side of Fell Street, creating a fifty
13	foot no-parking zone starting 10 feet east of the Masonic Intersection, to be
14	implemented in accordance with the California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco
15	Traffic Code.
