

1 [Accept and Expend Grant – San Francisco Drug Elimination Team - \$533,810]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Children, Youth & Their Families to**
4 **retroactively accept and expend grant funding in the amount of \$533,810 from**
5 **the California Emergency Management Agency to fund the San Francisco Drug**
6 **Elimination Team, a multi-disciplinary partnership, comprised of the San**
7 **Francisco Police Department, the District Attorney’s Office, and the Adult**
8 **Probation Department for the period of July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010.**

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10 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco was awarded a grant on
11 January 12, 2010 in the amount of \$533,810 from the California Emergency
12 Management Agency to fund the San Francisco Drug Elimination Team (DET), a multi-
13 disciplinary partnership comprised of the San Francisco Police Department, the District
14 Attorney’s Office, and the Adult Probation Department; and,

15 WHEREAS, The San Francisco DET is designed to abate illegal drug activity and
16 reduce violence in high-crime San Francisco neighborhoods through coordinated law
17 enforcement, prosecution, and probation efforts; and,

18 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department will employ a series of Rotating
19 Narcotic Enforcement Team (R-NET) operations to address street-level drug dealing,
20 violence, and gang activity; and,

21 WHEREAS, The San Francisco District Attorney’s Office will collaborate with DET
22 partners to ensure consistent charging and handling of DET/R-NET cases; and,

23 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Adult Probation Department will analyze, track, and
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1 classify all police incident reports generated from R-NET operations and place clients
2 in appropriate treatment modalities and increase contact with probationers in the
3 community; and,

4 WHEREAS, The Department of Children, Youth and Their Families will submit all
5 fiscal and programmatic reports to the California Emergency Management Agency in
6 FY 2009-2010; and,

7 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget;
8 and,

9 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; now therefore be it
10 RESOLVED, That the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families is hereby
11 authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant from the California Emergency
12 Management Agency in the amount of \$533,810 from July 1, 2009 through June 30,
13 2010.
