The City Planning Department has verified that the area is properly 14 zoned; and 15 WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license 16 application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it 17 RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business 18 and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San 19 Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the issuance of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises liquor license to Jonanthan Ching Yang Chiu for Eight, 20 21 located at 1151 Folsom Street will serve the public convenience and necessity of the 22 people of the City and County of San Francisco. 23 Conditions: (1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall only be permitted between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. each day of the week; (2) 24 25 The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited;

(3) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under control of the licensee; (4) Petitioners shall not permit their patrons or the general public to loiter or congregate on the sidewalks adjacent to the licensed premises; (5) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control; (6) The exterior sidewalks and parking lot(s) adjacent to the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons. (7) Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences.
