

[Changing Official Width of Sidewalk.]

Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1061 entitled “Regulating the Width of Sidewalks” by adding thereto Section No. 1558 to change the official sidewalk width at the southeast and southwest corners of Woodside and Idora Avenues; making findings pursuant to the General Plan and Planning Code Section 101.1; and requiring relocation, modification, or both of facilities affected by the sidewalk width changes.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning Department in its letter dated July 25, 2002, which stated that the actions contemplated herein are consistent with the Eight Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of such letter is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. _____.

Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works’ Order No. _____, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. _____, Board of Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled “Regulating the Width of Sidewalks,” a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General Ordinances, in effect May 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

Section 1558. The width of sidewalks at the southeast and southwest corners of Woodside and Idora Avenues shall be as shown on Department of Public Works drawing Q-20-557, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. _____.

1 Section 3. The Laguna Honda Hospital Replacement Program, as is necessary as a
2 result of this Ordinance, shall make arrangements with public utility companies and City
3 Departments for the relocation and/or adjustment of existing utility facilities in the affected
4 sidewalk and street areas.
