2 URGING A FULL POLICE INVESTIGATION INTO THE CAUSE OF THE AUTOMOBILE
3 ACCIDENT THAT KILLED 13-YEAR OLD PEDESTRIAN MARY LI IN THE CROSSWALK
4 OF BAYSHORE BOULEVARD ON OCTOBER 22, 1999, REQUESTING A POLICE REPORT
5 BY OCTOBER 29, 1999, AND URGING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO PROSECUTE
6 THE DRIVER OF THE VEHICLE THAT KILLED MARY LI TO THE FULLEST EXTENT
7 OF THE LAW.

8 WHEREAS, On October 22, 1999, 13-year old Mary Li was killed
9 while crossing the Bayshore Boulevard on her way to school; and,

10 WHEREAS, Mary Li, who was an 8th grader at Francisco Middle
11 School was in the crosswalk of Bayshore Boulevard and was crossing
12 the street at a green light when she was struck by a pick-up truck;
13 and,

14 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department is currently
15 attempting to locate witnesses and information in their investigation
16 into the cause of the automobile accident that killed the 13-year old
17 girl; and,

18 WHEREAS, This tragic accident is the second time this month that
19 a child has been killed on San Francisco's streets; now therefore be
20 it,

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County
22 of San Francisco hereby urges a full police investigation into the
23 cause of the automobile accident that killed 13-year old pedestrian
24 Mary Li in the crosswalk of Bayshore Boulevard on October 22, 1999;




