

Board Qualifications:

The Graffiti Advisory Board consists of twenty-five (25) voting members who shall be appointed as follows:

- A) One (1) member shall be the Mayor or his/her designee;
- B) Eleven (11) persons appointed by individual members of the Board of Supervisors, to serve a term of two years, at the pleasure of the appointing Supervisor (these appointments shall be effective when written notice of the appointment is received by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors); and
- C) The Board of Supervisors shall appoint the following members, who shall serve a term of two years:
 - > One (1) member representing youth groups who provide services for juveniles involved in alternative programs for graffiti diversion;
 - > One (1) employee, officer or member representing nonprofit organizations that provide services related to the City's beautification and neighborhood cleanup programs;
 - > Two (2) members representing businesses who operate in San Francisco, one of which must be a property owner where his/her business operates;
 - > One (1) employee or officer of a private school or art school who operate in San Francisco;
 - > One (1) employee or officer of the contracting agency for Municipal Railway shelters; and
 - > One (1) at-large member.
- D) The following officials and organizations shall each appoint one (1) member to serve on the Advisory Board:

- > The Director of Transportation of the Municipal Transportation Agency,
- > The Director of Public Works,
- > The General Manager of the Recreation and Park Department,
- > The District Attorney
- > The Chief of Police, and
- > The Board of Education of the San Francisco Unified School District may appoint one member. If the Board of Education fails to appoint a member within 60 days of a vacancy, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint a student, teacher, or member of the San Francisco Unified School District academic branch.

Reports: (a) Prepare and submit a report to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor every six months on graffiti, as it affects neighborhoods and the downtown area of San Francisco, which shall include a review and evaluation of the services and programs in place to respond to graffiti, prevention strategies, recommendations, and plans for a consolidated program of public and private efforts;

(b) Advise about the coordination of information, activities and goals among existing programs funded by the City and County and privately sponsored programs; and

(c) Advise about improving the efficiency in the provision of graffiti enforcement, prevention, and clean-up services.

Sunset Clause: The Advisory Board shall expire on March 11, 2019, unless the Board of Supervisors extends the term.

Seat 3, succeeding Christian Martin, term expired, must be appointed by the District 3 Supervisor, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 10, 2021.

Seat 4, Camelin Blackstone, term expiring April 10, 2021, must be appointed by the District 4 Supervisor, for a two-year term.

Seat 5, succeeding Jana Lord, term expired, must be appointed by the District 5 Supervisor, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 10, 2021.

Seat 6, succeeding Daniel Pan, term expired, must be appointed by the District 6 Supervisor, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 10, 2021.

Seat 7, Jessica Cabrera, term expiring April 10, 2021, must be appointed by the District 7 Supervisor, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term.

Seat 8, Penni Wisner, term expiring April 10, 2021, must be appointed by the District 8 Supervisor, for a two-year term.

Seat 9, succeeding Todd Berman, term expired, must be appointed by the District 9 Supervisor, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 10, 2021.

Seat 10, Earl Shaddix, term expiring April 10, 2021, must be appointed by the District 10 Supervisor, for a two-year term.

Seat 11, succeeding Grace Breyley, term expired, must be appointed by the District 11 Supervisor, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 10, 2021.

Vacant Seat 12, succeeding John Austin, resigned, must represent youth groups that provides services for juveniles involved in alternative programs for graffiti diversion, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 10, 2021.

Seat 13, succeeding Darcy Brown, term expired, must be an employee, officer or member of a nonprofit organization that provides services related to the City's beautification and neighborhood cleanup programs, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 10, 2021.

Seat 15, succeeding Daniel Kling, term expired, must represent a business that operates in San Francisco, and either seat 14 or 15 must own the property where his or her business operates, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 10, 2021.

Seat 16, Mike Petrica, term ending April 10, 2021, must be an employee or officer of a private school or art school that operates in San Francisco, for a two-year term.

Seat 17, Margeaux Cstillas, term expiring April 10, 2021, must be an employee or officer of the contracting agency for Municipal Railway shelters, for a two-year term.

Seat 18, Gregory Dillon, term expiring March 11, 2020, must be an at-large member of the public, for a two-year term ending March 11, 2022.

Additional Qualifications: Members shall be broadly representative of the ethnic, racial, gender, age, and sexual orientation diversity of the City and County of San Francisco. Appointing authorities shall appoint persons from varying backgrounds who have demonstrated abilities, skills, or experience with youth or addressing blight in neighborhoods.

Report: The Advisory Board shall prepare and submit a report to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor every six months on graffiti as it affects neighborhoods and the downtown area of San Francisco, which shall include a review and evaluation of the services and programs in place to respond to graffiti, prevention strategies, recommendations, and plans regarding a consolidated program of public and private efforts.



Applicants applying for seats 12 through 17, who meet minimum qualifications, will be contacted by the Rules Committee Clerk once the Rules Committee Chair determines the date of the hearing. Members of the Rules Committee will consider the appointment(s) at the meeting, and applicants may be asked to state their qualifications. The appointment(s) of the individual(s) who are recommended by the Rules Committee will be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors for final approval.
