2	Resolution recognizing the week of May 24 through June 1, 2025, as Queer and
3	Transgender Asian and Pacific Islander Week in the City and County of San Francisco.

5	WHEREAS, The Bay Area Queer and Transgender Asian and Pacific Islander (QTAPI)
6	Coalition was formed on February 7, 2019, to build community, facilitate intergenerational
7	transfer of knowledge, recognize the QTAPI community's historical context and
8	interdependence, and celebrate their unique cultural heritage and identity; and
9	WHEREAS, The Bay Area QTAPI Coalition includes organizations and community
10	groups such as Lavender Phoenix (formerly API Equality Northern California (APIENC)),
11	Asian Pacific Islander Queer Women & Transgender Community (APIQWTC), GLBTQ+ Asian
12	Pacific Alliance (GAPA), AAPI Caucus of the Harvey Milk LGBTQ Democratic Club, Parivar
13	Bay Area, Prism Foundation, Red Envelope Giving Circle, API Transmasculine Anthology,
14	API TransFusion, Chinese Cultural Center of San Francisco, Edge on the Square, GLBT
15	Historical Society, Japantown Rainbow Coalition, San Francisco Community Health Center,
16	San Francisco AIDS Foundation, Essence of Mana, North County Outreach, QT Nightlife aka
17	RIZE SF, and members of the Rice Rockettes; and
18	WHEREAS, The Bay Area QTAPI Coalition organized the first QTAPI Week in San
19	Francisco on May 22, 2021, through May 29, 2021, the first in the country and the world,
20	starting on Harvey Milk Day in the Castro during Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI)
21	Heritage Month; and
22	WHEREAS, The Bay Area QTAPI Coalition supported efforts by QTAPI people
23	statewide and nationally to organize their own local QTAPI Weeks to counteract and heal from
24	the discrimination, violence, and disproportional harm by unjust systems; and

1	WHEREAS, Community-based organizations across the QTAPI spectrum have
2	provided support, advocacy, and health and safety services to the Bay Area QTAPI
3	community for over 45 years; and
4	WHEREAS, Newer grassroots organizations formed at the turn of the millennium have
5	continued to respond to ongoing systems of oppression and pandemic crises by supporting
6	and organizing QTAPI people in the Bay Area; and
7	WHEREAS, QTAPI Week is a time when organizers demonstrate the strength and
8	resilience of the Asian American community in the face of continued violence as well as pride
9	in identity as part of the LGBTQ+ community; and
10	WHEREAS, During QTAPI Week, the Bay Area QTAPI Coalition will host the first-ever
11	Chinatown Pride Procession, the first-ever QTAPI Strong: A March for Resilience, Justice &
12	Belonging from City Hall to Trans Thrive, QTAPI Tapestry Closing Block Party in the heart of
13	the Castro in partnership with Castro Art Mart, networking activities, voter engagement and
14	capacity building events, and supportive facilitated conversations that further the work of the
15	QTAPI movement in San Francisco, the San Francisco Bay Area, statewide in California, and
16	beyond; and
17	WHEREAS, The Bay Area QTAPI Coalition continues to grow and respond to the
18	issues facing the QTAPI community; now, therefore be it
19	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
20	hereby recognizes May 24, 2025 through June 1, 2025, as Queer and Transgender Asian and
21	Pacific Islander (QTAPI) Week; and, be it
22	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
23	Francisco commends the Bay Area QTAPI Coalition for organizing, mobilizing, and inspiring
24	the QTAPI community, and for lifting up the numerous contributions made by the QTAPI

community locally, nationally, and globally.
