Contractor: Westside Community Mental Health Center

Contract Amendment Amount: \$13,691,234

- **Not-to-Exceed Amount:** \$21,466,168

Timeline: Total term of June 2, 2025, through June 30, 2028

- Extends contract term by 2 years

Contract Summary: The Eleanora Fagan Center provides short-term respite beds plus health stabilization support for people experiencing homelessness.

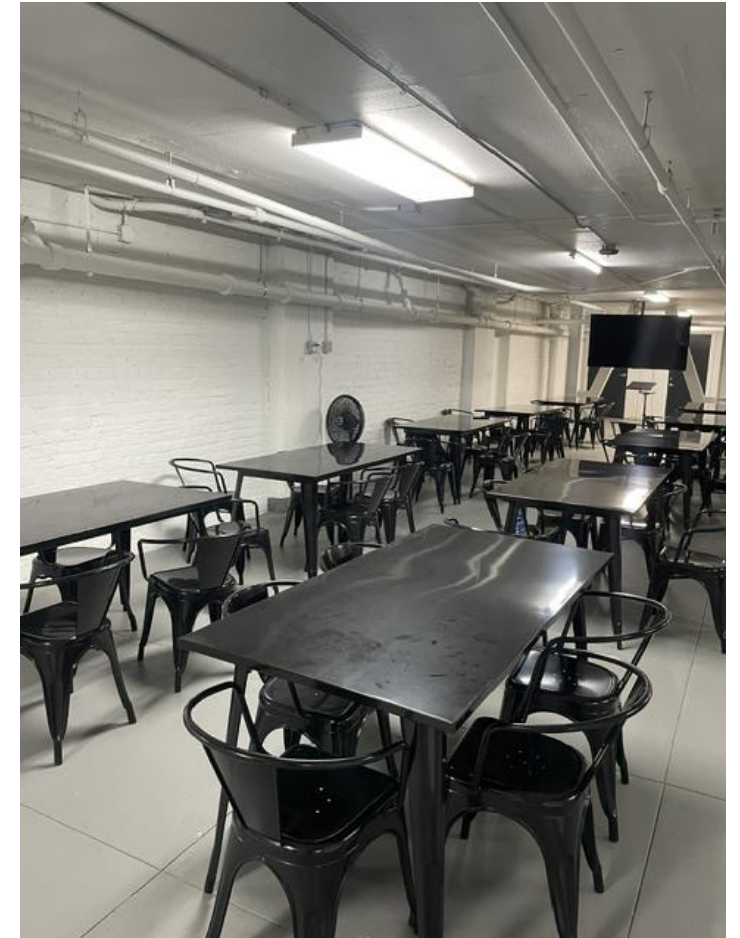
Program Summary



Summary: Eleanora Fagan Center (EFC) provides a safe place for unhoused individuals who use substances as their first step exiting homelessness. Individuals receive direct support and linkages to housing, treatment, & recovery in a drug-free environment.

- EFC is a partnership between Westside Community Services, SFDPH Behavioral Health Services, and SF Homelessness and Supportive Housing.
- All clients residing at the EFC will have an assessment by the Westside field-based team to establish a stabilization plan for both medical and behavioral health needs.
- Clients can stay for up to 3 months before moving to the next step towards health and recovery. The program has the capacity to serve 72 clients.
