

1 [Calling for a Boycott of the Major League Baseball Team Arizona Diamondbacks Until
2 Arizona Repeals Senate Bill 1070]

3 **Resolution calling for a boycott of the Arizona Diamondbacks, an Arizona-based**
4 **business, until Arizona repeals Senate Bill 1070 and supporting the San Francisco**
5 **Giants.**

7 WHEREAS, The Arizona Legislature passed SB 1070, which the Arizona Governor,
8 Jan Brewer, signed into law on April 23, 2010 and,

9 WHEREAS, SB 1070 requires the police “when practicable” to detain people they
10 “reasonably suspect” are in the country without authorization; allows the police to charge
11 immigrants with a state crime for not carrying immigration documents; and makes it a crime to
12 stop on a public street to attempt to hire a temporary worker; and,

13 WHEREAS, Republican politicians voted unanimously for the draconian Arizona State
14 Proposition SB 1070; and

15 WHEREAS, Ken Kendrick owner of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2010 was the 3rd
16 highest contributor at \$121,600 to the National Republican Senatorial Committee; the 18th
17 highest contributor to at \$129,500 to the Republican Party Committee; the 20th highest
18 contributor at \$9,400 to Senator McCain; and,

19 WHEREAS, While Arizona Diamondbacks Managing General Partner Ken Kendrick
20 now claims to oppose SB 1070, he and his family members, EG Kendrick, Sr. and Randy
21 Kendrick have made significant contributions to further the Republican Agenda totaling
22 \$1,023,527; and,

23 WHEREAS, Roughly 40% of Major League baseball players are Latino; and

24 WHEREAS, Protests or boycotts of the Arizona Diamondbacks have already occurred
25 in Denver and Chicago and are planned for Miami; and

1 WHEREAS, The Arizona Diamondbacks are scheduled to play in San Francisco May
2 28th, May 29th, and May 30th, and

3 WHEREAS, SB 1070 on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. , ,
4 which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; now,
5 therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, that unless and until Arizona rescinds SB 1070, the City and County of
7 San Francisco calls for a boycott of all Arizona Diamondbacks games, both home and away in
8 the regular and post season, and encourages San Franciscans not to purchase or wear
9 Arizona Diamondback memorabilia; and be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco calls on those
11 concerned about immigrant rights to protest the Arizona Diamondbacks in San Francisco on
12 May 28th – May 30th; and be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco supports the San
14 Francisco Giants and encourages our fans to attend Giants games at AT&T Park May 25th –
15 May 27th against the Washington Nationals and May 31st – June 2nd against the Colorado
16 Rockies; and be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco encourages the
18 San Francisco Giants and San Francisco Giants fans to wear Gigantes uniforms May 28th –
19 May 30th during our home stand against the Arizona Diamondbacks to show our support for
20 Latino baseball players and the Latino and immigrant communities.
