9 13, 2010 at 3:00pm to hear two ordinances approving and adopting amendments to the  
10 Redevelopment Plans for the Bayview Hunters Point and Hunters Point Shipyard  
11 Redevelopment Project Areas (Board Files 100658 and 100659). The proposed ordinances  
12 also approve and authorize an Interagency Cooperation Agreement between the City and  
13 County of San Francisco and the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San  
14 Francisco, in furtherance of the adoption and implementation of the Redevelopment Plan  
15 Amendments; adopt findings pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act; adopt  
16 findings that the Redevelopment Plan Amendment is consistent with the City's General Plan  
17 and Eight Priority Policies of City Planning Code Section 101.1; and adopt other findings  
18 pursuant to California Community Redevelopment Law, including findings pursuant to  
19 Sections 33445 and 33445.1.
